

What is considered First Aid?

- Non-prescription drugs at nonprescription doses
- * Tetanus immunization
- Cleaning, flushing, soaking wounds on skin surface
- Use of bandages, butterfly,
 Steri-strips
- Hot or cold therapy
- Non-rigid supports
- * Drilling nail to relieve pressure
- * Drain fluid from blister

- * Use eye patch
- Foreign body removed from eye with irrigation or cotton swab
- Remove splinter or foreign material by irrigation, tweezers, cotton swab
- * Use finger guards
- Massage (physical therapy and chiropractic treatment are medical treatment)
- * Drinking fluids for heat stress relief

Notify OSHA

You must notify OSHA for:

- ⇒ Fatality within 8 hours
- \Rightarrow Hospitalization (1 or more) within 24 hours
- ⇒ Amputation within 24 hours
- \Rightarrow Loss of Eye within 24 hours
